- Fire Salvage
 - Sales package approved
 - Logging ongoing
 - o To ramp up with colder weather

Log Sales

- CH1 logging pushed to January
- CH2 and 3 require final amendments from Arch branch.

Fuel Treatments- Ongoing

- Shulus
 - Almost finished cutting and piling 55 ha
 - Funded by CRI and WRR. Burning to follow this fall/winter.
- Skeetchestn
 - Award approved in Sept
 - Work started on 64 hectares, to complete by March 2025
 - Funded by FESBC

Road Rehab Project

- Site prep and planting season complete
- Reforestation plan to be broken out across multiple years so LLCF has less exposure to extreme weather events that could cause widespread seedling mortality in a single year

Fuel treatments- Planned

- Submission to FESBC
 - o Request submitted for \$580,000
- Fuel Treatment, Light Pink
 - Near Municipal Campground
 - o 47 hectares
 - o \$400,000 requested
- Fuel Prescription, Red
 - o 260 hectares
 - \$120,000 for prescription development

Log Poaching

- Forsite discovered several felled trees near HVOA gun range
- ~50 trees cut, some black some green
- Reported to Ministry of Forest Compliance and Enforcement & Tenures staff

BC Community Forest Association

- Victoria session with government staff
- New Wildland Urban Interface regulations coming
- Fuel Treatments to become an obligation
- BCCFA pushing for alternative outcome due to concerns this will adversely affect fuel treatment

Strategic

New CFA MOU with Lower Nicola

- Previous MOU signed in 2019
- Recent "Apportionment" letter from the Ministry for the Kamloops Timber Supply Area "No new
- Renew conversation with Lower Nicola... next steps?
